# **Getting Support with Completing Application Forms**

Staff and Volunteers in your local Citizens Information Centre are experienced in supporting people to complete social welfare forms. The service is free and confidential.

Specifically, they should be able to help you as a carer understand the eligibility criteria and if necessary complete The Carer's Allowance, Carer's Benefit and Respite Care Grant application forms. They can also print off these application forms from a computer in their offices.
